The Tagliatela College of Engineering at the University of New Haven invites applications for a tenure track assistant professor position in the area of **structural engineering**. The expected starting date is September 1, 2013. The academic home for the successful candidate will be the Department of Mechanical, Civil and Environmental Engineering. A dual appointment is possible.

Responsibilities: teaching structural analysis and design courses with a focus on sustainable civil structures; teaching fundamental courses in the TCoE Multidisciplinary Engineering Foundation Spiral Curriculum; exhibiting excellence in teaching at both undergraduate and graduate levels and a special commitment to laboratory and project-based instruction; pursuing funded research with a focus in the areas of structurally engineered systems (steel / concrete) and structural system modeling; supervising graduate and undergraduate student research; recruiting and advising students; and participating in course/program development and service to the department, college and university.

Required qualifications: Ph.D. in civil or structural engineering; strong communications-and interpersonal skills; superior experimental skills; ability to interact and collaborate on research with faculty inside and outside the university, and a commitment to collegiality and teamwork. Documentation of authorization to work in the U.S. is also required. A Professional Engineering license is desirable; at a minimum, the successful candidate must have the ability and willingness to achieve licensure within four to five years of hire.

Application Process: All information on candidates will be kept confidential. Review of applications will start in November 2012 and will continue until the position is filled. Qualified candidates should submit a cover letter describing their academic and/or industry experiences relevant to the position, curriculum vitae, statement of teaching philosophy, brief statement of research plans, and contact information for at least three professional references to:
