The University of New Haven has an opening in its Political Science Department for a tenure-track Assistant Professor beginning fall semester 2013. The department seeks a dynamic instructor and scholar to teach a variety of courses in American Government and Politics (national, state and local) and courses in modern political analysis. Field of specialization open, but should engage one or more of the following areas: minority political participation, immigration and demographic impacts on political processes and representation, gender and political behavior, urban politics or related areas. The successful candidate will be expected to establish/continue a strong and independent program of research that would attract extramural support (when necessary).

This position is one of two tenure-track positions, as the Political Science Department is looking to expand its course offerings and experiential learning opportunities for students. We are especially interested in candidates who have demonstrated creativity in developing new courses or who have found innovative ways to deliver traditional courses.

The Political Science Department is part of the Division of Humanities and Social Sciences, which creates an abundance of opportunities for interdisciplinary collaboration among the faculty who teach in our social science programs. A PhD in Political Science is required (ABDs very close to completion will be considered for interviews, but must be complete by fall 2013); Successful grant applications a plus.
