The **University of New Haven** invites applications for a renewable **non-tenure-track** (NTT) Lecturer position in Mathematics to begin Fall 2013. The successful candidate will join a department with growing student course enrollments, a strong commitment to teaching, and a faculty with diverse teaching and research interests.

The position supports the instructional needs of the Department in teaching a wide range of courses from developmental mathematics through the calculus sequence, and includes teaching introductory classes in finite mathematics and discrete mathematics. The AY 2013-14 teaching load is 4 lecture sections per semester.

Minimum requirements include a Masters in Mathematics with at least one year experience in teaching. Experience with instructional technology using web based instructional software, or other learning management systems is a consideration, as is a desire to work with undergraduates. Excellent written and oral communication skills are necessary, as is evidence of teaching effectiveness.
