## Frequently Observed Behaviors/ Topics for Discussion:

- Apprehension about going home for the holidays and leaving new friends/relationships
- Anxiety and sleeplessness due to finals and preparation for finals
- Anxiety about whether old relationships back home will still be in tact
- Sense of missing out on holiday traditions and activities due to schoolwork
- Financial aid deadlines may cause anxiety

## **Advice for Family Members:**

- Talk with your student about academic major choices and career goals. Career Services and the Center for Academic Success can offer guidance and support in this area.
- Send a "Good Luck On Finals Care Package"
- Spark conversation about Spring class registration and internships
- Talk with your student about coming home and their hopes/ anxieties associated with it
- Plan a holiday activity to do together (tree decorating, baking cookies, etc.) when your student gets home
