Two record-setting players representing the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference garnered the top honors on the 2009 Daktronics, Inc., All-America team, as Lock Haven pitcher Kristen Erb landed the "Pitcher of the Year" award for the third consecutive season and Kutztown first baseman Steph Denlinger was chosen as the national "Player of the Year" on the squad that is voted on by sports information directors in NCAA Division II.

Erb, a senior pitcher for the Lady Eagles – who will be playing at the Division II Softball Championships this weekend – has gone 45-4 with a national-best 0.44 earned run average during the 2009 campaign. She has also fanned 351 hitters in 317 innings and has allowed only 193 hitters to reach base by either hit or walk.

She is joined on the first team by national strikeout leader Marjorie Johnson of Southeastern Oklahoma State and Nicole Anderson of Rollins, who is also among the top five in the nation in strikeouts per seven innings.

Denlinger broke the NCAA Division II record for career home runs in 2009, hitting 23 to finish her career with 79 round trippers. She heads up a power-packed first team as five of the top seven home run hitters in Division II are members of that first team.

The co-holder of the lead in that category, Valdosta State freshman Marti Littlefield, hit 25 homers and is the only player in the nation with over 100 runs batted in. The other player with 25 homers, Angelo State freshman Sandy James, is the second-team first baseman to Denlinger.

Alabama-Huntsville third baseman Beth Lawson and St. Mary's utility player Arylnda Flores, who have 24 homers apiece, are also on the first team along with Metropolitan State's Tara Mickelson, who blasted 22 from the designated player spot in the lineup.

Another player among the top 10 in homers, Southwest Minnesota State's Amanda Burkhart, is one of the first-team outfielders along with Texas A&M-Kingsville's Cassie Anderson and UC San Diego's Kristyn Leskovsky.

Abilene Christian catcher Jessica Shiery, the national leader in on-base percentage, is the first team catcher and Edinboro's Dana Webb was chosen as the first-teamer at second base.

The 10 position players on the first team have combined to hit .422 with a total of 178 home runs and 615 runs batted in. The three pitchers have a combined record of 98-16 with an earned run average of 0.67 and 1,100 strikeouts.
