The applicant must be able to effectively tutor up through Calculus III and through the 200-level in either physics or chemistry.

Duties will include tutoring primarily undergraduate students in the areas of math and one other subject, typically on the 100- and 200-levels. The applicant should be comfortable tutoring students individually and in small groups and recording data from those sessions. Tutors may be asked to prepare and present workshops during their scheduled shifts, preview new software, and help create in-house resources for the CLR.
