Student Rules and Responsibilities

- 1) A minimum of 3 filming sessions is required.
- 2) Complete the following waivers and forms:
 - Rules and responsibilities
 - Equipment release
- 3) Proper language is to be used on film. Swearing, vulgarities, and inappropriate humor are prohibited.
- 4) Alcohol, drugs, and illegal activities are prohibited on camera.
- 5) If you film at your service site, you **MUST** seek permission from the site supervisor prior to filming. If you film the clients/students at your service site, they must complete the photo release and this **MUST** be submitted to the ASL Office. Video footage without these completed forms cannot be used.
- 6) During a private reflection piece, please wear a UNH shirt if possible. Dress at your service site should remain professional.
- 7) Filming projects should be completed by November 30, 2009. At this time, all equipment and video footage should be returned to the ASL Office.
- 8) Do not post any video footage to the internet.
- 9) Video is for academic purposes **ONLY**.
