

A REMINDER TO ALL UNDERGRADUATE AND GRADUATE STUDENTS:

As you prepare to register for classes for the winter and spring semesters/trimesters you may notice a hold on your matrix account, preventing you from registering. If the hold is from Health Services, it means that we have not received your immunization records and/or physical.

The University of New Haven and The State of Connecticut require that all (both full and part-time) students have:

- **Two valid measles vaccines**. The first measles vaccine must be *after your first birthday and after January 1st, 1969*. The second measles vaccine must be *30 days after the first vaccination and after January 1st, 1980*.

- **Valid rubella vaccine** anytime *after your first birthday*.

ALL Full time students are also required to have:

- **A physical exam** that was conducted *no less than one year ago*. You may find a downloadable version of the physical form at:

ALL Students living on campus and in university owned housing (graduate and undergraduate students) as well as athletes are also required to have:

- **Valid meningitis vaccine**

Please remember that the hold will remain on your account until the above documents are received and validated by our office. **The hold will prevent you from registering from classes, paying your bill, accessing blackboard, and receiving your grades.** Immunization/Physical exam documents may be dropped off, mailed, or faxed to our office.
