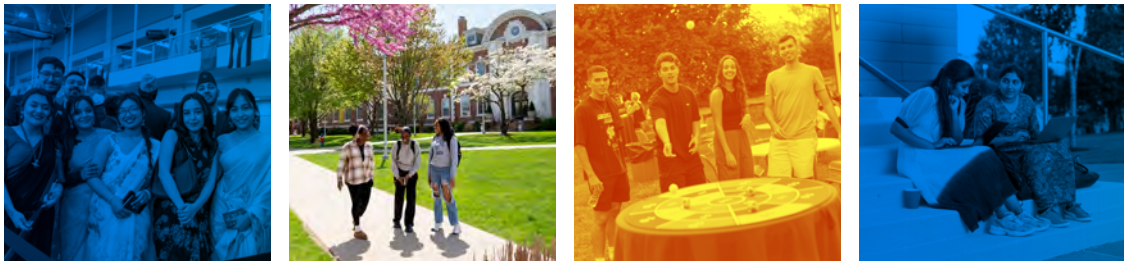
**University Immigration Services - MANDATORY Session for ALL International Students** (Bucknall Theater)
