It is a learning management system (LMS) used by to manage online courses and learning materials. It provides tools for instructors to post course content, assignments, and grades, and for students to access and engage with the course.



Navigate

Allows students to connect with the right people and resources. Students can schedule appointments with teachers or advisors, receive important updates by email or text, and get timely help through academic alerts that activate support services.



Self Service Banner

This is a one-stop hub for academics. Here students register for classes, view schedules, check official grades and transcripts, manage financial aid and payments, update personal information.

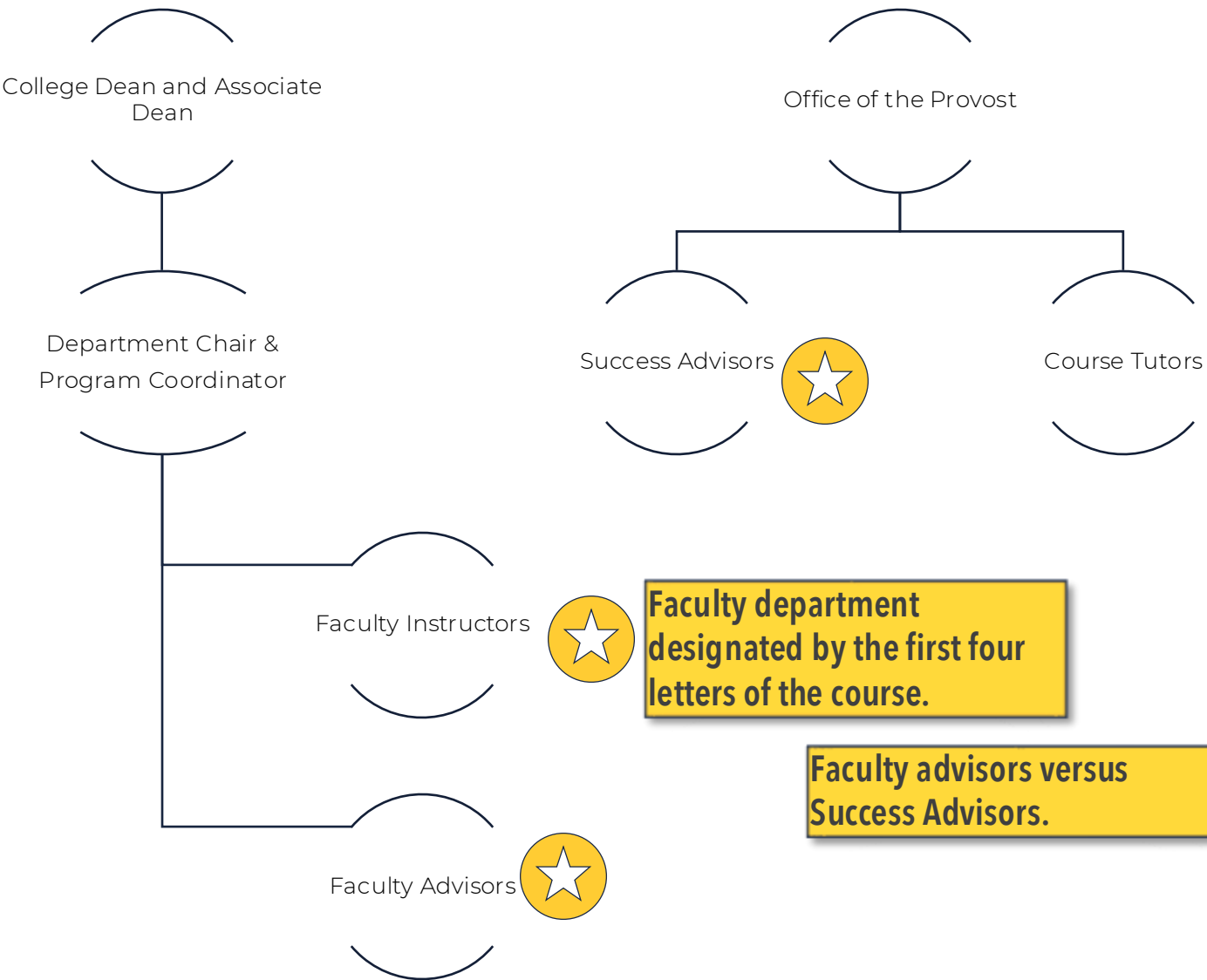

CENTER FOR ADVISING AND ACADEMIC SUPPORT (CASA)

Full time staff and peers to assist students with a variety of needs

- > Success Advisors available for general academic questions that come up along the way

- > Understanding Degree Audit, degree progression, major options and GPA calculations

- > Assist with course registration prior to course selection days, and the morning of

- > Progress Report Outreach will come from our Success Advisors

- > Academic Peer Mentors available to support students in a variety of ways

- > Walk-in and scheduled appointments for students everyday of the week

Academic Support

TUTORING AND ACADEMIC SUPPORT CENTER (TASC)

Main tutoring center on campus

- > Offer both in person and online tutoring options
- > CRLA trained Peer Tutors work to provide lessons geared toward individual students
- > Professional Tutors available for general academic concerns or content support
- > Metacognitive approach to student learning
- > Learning Assistant offering embedded tutoring in courses
