

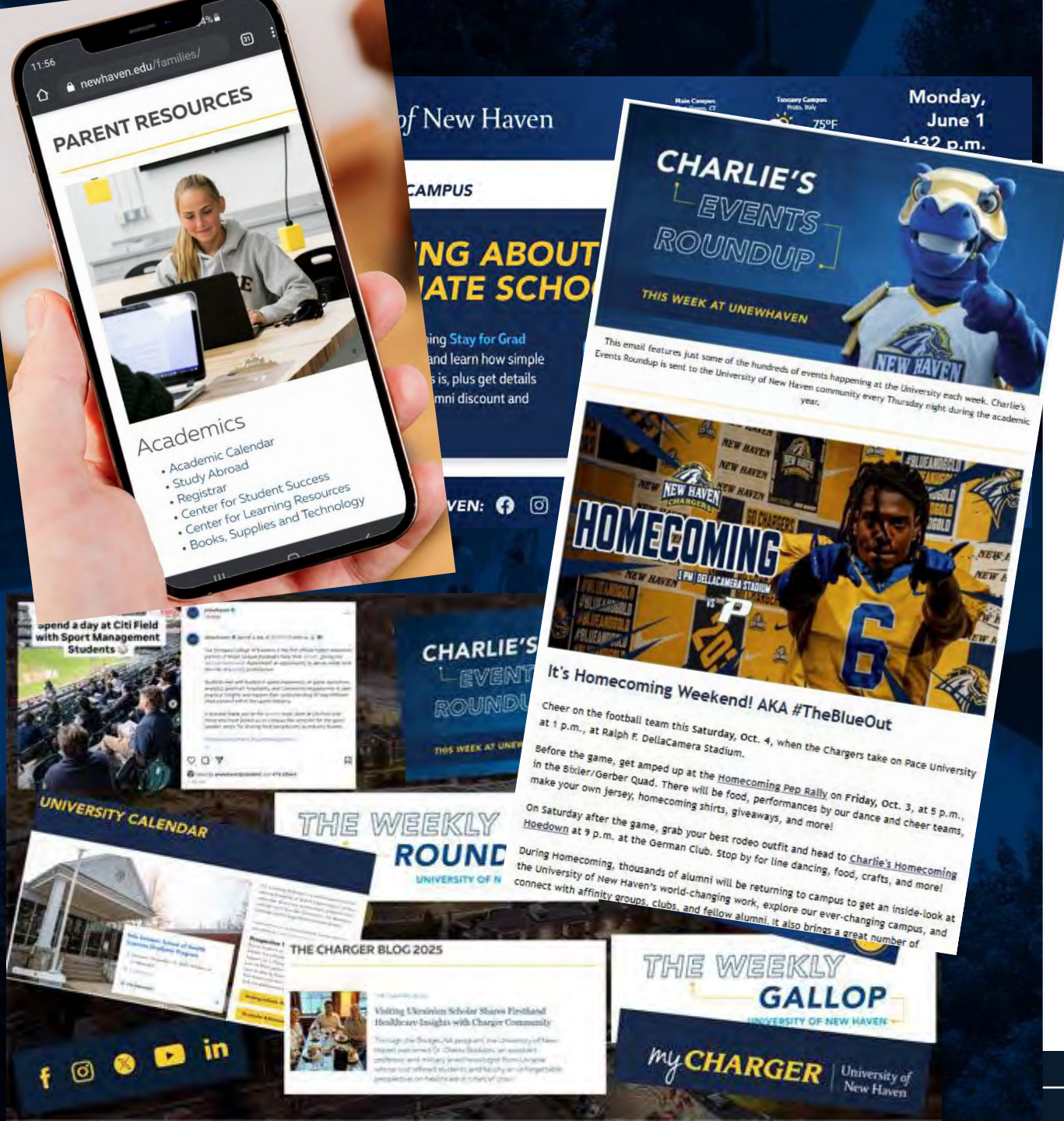

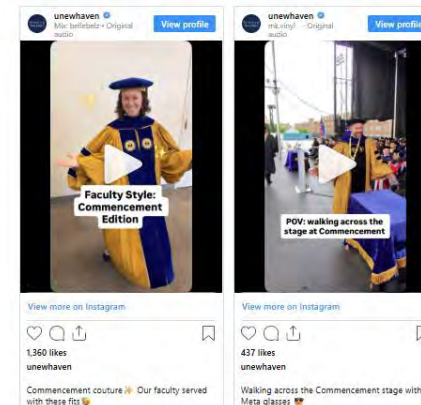

During two ceremonies on Friday and Saturday, the University awarded more than 3,100 undergraduate, master's, and doctoral degrees. Combined, nearly 9,000 guests attended the ceremonies.

"As we leave here and step into whatever comes next, like jobs, grad school, uncertainty, and opportunity, I hope we carry this with us: Be present, be grounded," Samantha Villa '26, who earned her bachelor's degree in criminal justice, told her classmates on Saturday. "And as my grandma would say, 'Be where your feet are,' even as those feet start moving once again. Because we earned this pride. We earned this unity. We earned the right to stand here as Chargers, as graduates, and as people who did not just make it through college. We lived it. We shaped it. And we shaped each other. Class of 2026, take one last look at where your feet are today. Then look up, because wherever they land next, we are ready."

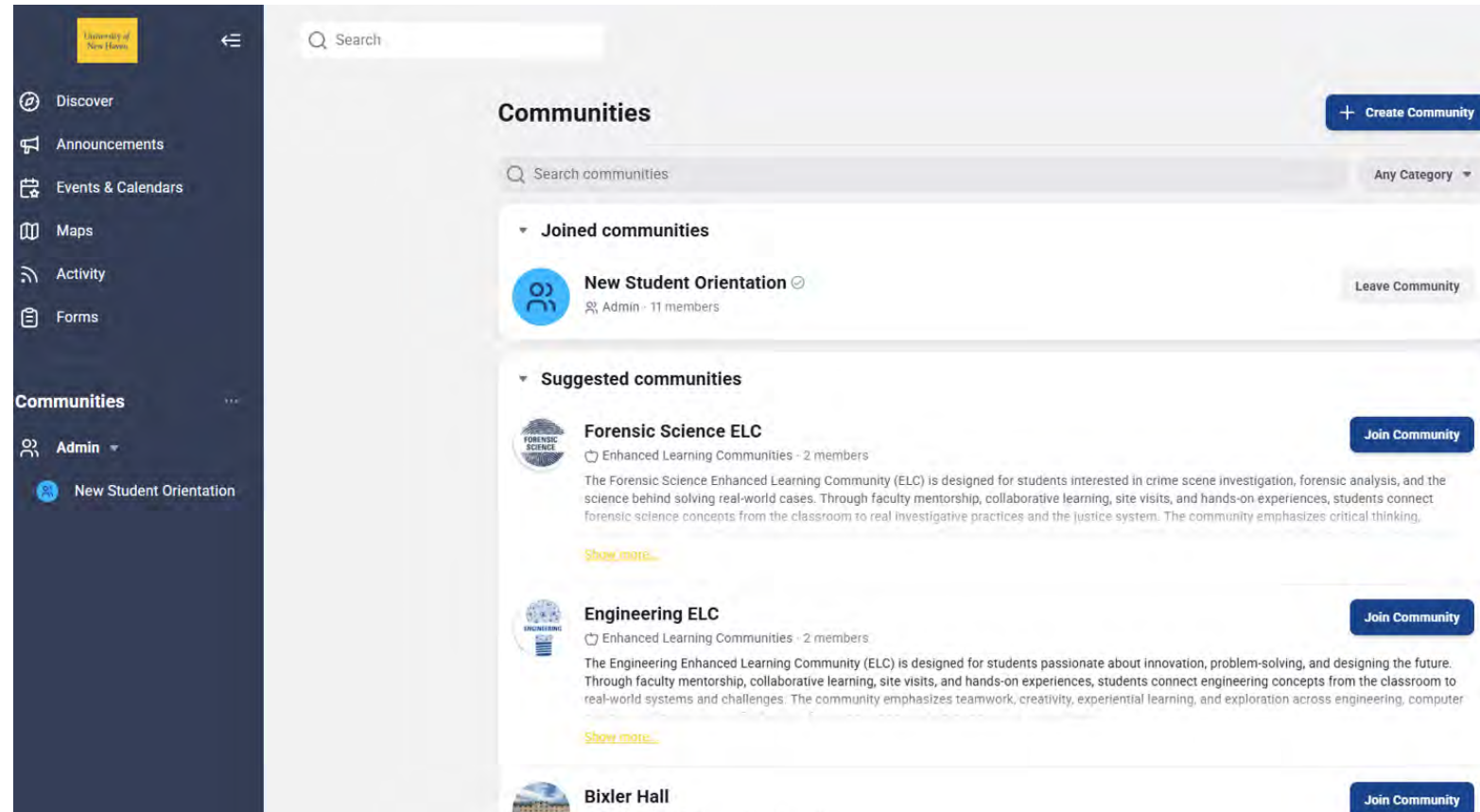
