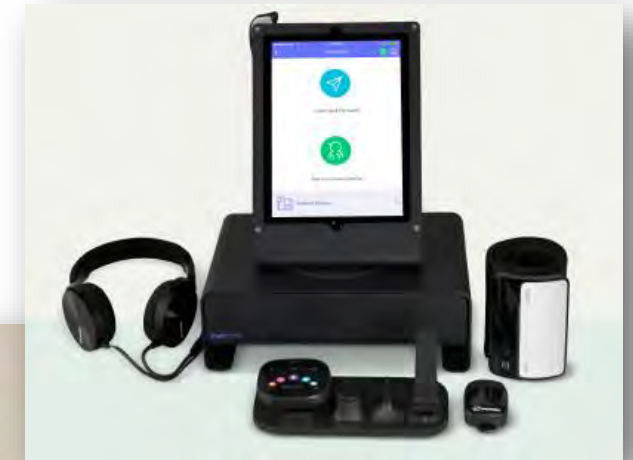

- Health insurance card to be scanned in via MyChart Plus
- List of any past health problems or surgeries
- List of all your medications (including the dose and how often you take it)

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Pharmacy Delivery

Health Services has partnered with a local pharmacy provider, **Liberty Pharmacy**, to have prescriptions delivered directly to campus for pickup at Student Health Services.

Students must set up an account with Liberty by phone and be prepared to provide:
Demographic information, Insurance, Name of Medication, and Form of Payment

Information for Prescribers

- The student's prescriber will need to send the prescription directly to **Liberty Pharmacy** with the student's demographic and insurance information.
- Prescriber must note on the script "**University of New Haven Student Health**" as an identifier to ensure delivery to Student Health Services.
- E-script is the best method of sending prescriptions to Liberty Pharmacy. The PCP may need the Pharmacy's NPI: 16-89429946

Health Insurance

Verify Your Coverage

- Please contact your insurance member services
- Ensure that **Hartford Healthcare Medical Group, Specialty**, is in network with your insurance
- Provide them with Tax ID Number: **37-1911194**
- Any billing questions should be directed to **1-877-HHC-BILL** (1-877-442-2455)

Ask Your Insurance

- If you have an out-of-state insurance plan, verify that services in Connecticut are covered.
- Confirm that your plan includes out-of-network and/or out-of-state benefits.

Consider enrolling in the University Student Health Insurance Plan if your coverage is limited.

Health Requirements for New Students

- ✓ Demographic information, emergency contact, and health history
- ✓ Physical exam within 12 months of starting classes (or within 6 months if student-athlete)
- ✓ Immunizations
- ✓ TB screening questionnaire and test results if indicated
- ✓ Government ID
- ✓ Health Insurance- Uploading it to PyraMED does not waive the university health insurance.

All the required health forms listed above are available on your University of New Haven MyCharger account or can be downloaded from the Roadmap.

This information helps Health Services take better care of you and ensure a healthy community.

Immunization Requirements

REQUIRED by Connecticut Law

- 2 doses of MMR (measles, mumps, rubella) vaccine or documentation of immunity
 - The 1st dose is invalid if received before 12 months of age
- 2 doses of varicella (chickenpox) or documentation of immunity
- 1 dose of meningitis (MCV4) **within 5 years** of matriculation date
- Required only for residential students and student-athletes

RECOMMENDED

- COVID-19 series, including booster doses
- Meningitis (MCV4) and Meningitis B vaccines
- Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis) vaccine
- Hepatitis A and Hepatitis B vaccine series
- HPV vaccine series

Health Form Submission

- Students will use the **PyraMED** portal to upload their Health Requirements using single sign-on with their University email and password.
- **PryaMED**- <https://newhaven.studenthealthportal.com/>
- Health records will only be reviewed through the PyraMED portal, and cannot be submitted in alternative formats (email, etc.).
- Students can submit the university-provided health form, or can submit documents from their providers, as long as they meet all the requirements.
- Students will be contacted directly through the portal's secure messaging system.
- Please expect **5** business days for review of records.

At the University of New Haven, we value your health and that of our entire campus community.

Please note, new incoming students starting the Fall semester, records should be submitted by August 1; for Spring start, records should be submitted by January 5. Any delays in submitting health records should be communicated to healthservices@newhaven.edu

The medical information form can be found on your accepted student portal or in [MyCharger](#) on the Health Services page.

Health Requirements for **ALL STUDENTS**

- **MMR** (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) - two doses after 12 months of age OR blood test to prove immunity (submit lab results). Vaccines before 12 months of age are invalid. MMRV is also acceptable.
- **Varicella** (Chicken Pox) - two doses OR history of disease documented by a healthcare provider, OR blood test to prove immunity (submit lab results). MMRV is also acceptable.
- **Physical Exam** within 12 months of starting classes, the university medical examination form will need to be completed by a medical provider.
- **Tuberculosis Screening** - TB Screening Questionnaire (Part 1) - must be completed by **all students**. TB Test Result (Part 2) - **only** if indicated based on answers to questionnaire. Either a TB skin test or a TB blood test is acceptable. If either test is positive, a chest X-ray is required.
- **Government ID** - Upload a picture of a driver's License, learner's permit, or passport.
- **Health Insurance Card** -

Immunization History Form

- Immunization history dates for vaccines or titers will be entered in the Immunization History Form.
- Students should enter dates for which they have supporting documentation.
- Students should pay attention to the **RED** headings, which are specific to student groups
- Documentation should be uploaded in this form for any dates entered.
