The Department of Chemistry and Chemical Engineering at the University of New Haven invites applications for adjunct professors to teach various courses including General Chemistry, Organic Chemistry, Analytical Chemistry and Physical Chemistry during the Fall 2020 semester, with a potential to extend into future semesters. The teaching load will consist of lectures and/or labs in the described fields with the applicant's specialties and experience being taken into account. In most cases course content will be provided for adaptation.

A minimum of a Master's degree in Chemistry or related field is required, Ph.D. preferred. The ideal candidates have some teaching experience at the college level and a commitment to student-centered teaching. Preference will be given to those with a record of teaching excellence at the university level. Familiarity with online teaching is a plus.

Please submit a brief cover letter explaining teaching experience, philosophy and a list of which courses you are able and interested in teaching, a CV, and the name and contact information for three references. Applicants may also include up to 3 artifacts of teaching ability (examples include syllabi, student evaluations, learning exercises, assignments, or other feedback) that illustrate teaching experience.
